Margerum 2015 Klickitat Pinot Gris

The Klickitat Pinot Gris vines are located on the eastern foothills of the Cascade Mountains in Klickitat County, Washington.

An explosion of citrus, blood orange, and finger limes combined with wet river stone minerality provide a lean, focused mouthfeel. The natural acidity forms a linear focus, and barrel aged Lees contact provides a slight velvety texture rounding out the palate.

Margerum 2017 Riviera Reserve Rosé

This wine is a barrel fermented and barrel aged Rosé made primarily from Grenache with accents of Mourvèdre, Syrah, and Cinsaut. We pick Grenache specifically for our rosé production.

The grapes are crushed and immediately pressed to stainless tank for cold settling. We then filter and bottle early to capture brightness and vibrancy.

Margerum 2016 Viognier

As a predecessor to our Margerum Estate Viognier, we made this 2016 Viognier from two select vineyards - one in the cool climate of Happy Canyon and the other in the cooler rolling hills of the Los Olivos District.

The resulting wine is full, round, opulent with a balanced acidity. The wine is just basically lovely, delicious and special.
