To make the best M5 possible, we take the five varietals and blend them together looking for harmony, color, flavor, aroma, complexity and nuance. Blending is our forte and invariably there are some remaining lots not selected to reach a final M5 blend. We then take these lots to make a very delicious and gulpable red wine that will satiate your thirst all summer long. For the times in life when you want something a little less serious, Le Restant is the perfect go to wine.

Vineyard Regions: 85% Los Olivos District (Margerum Estate), 9% Santa Rita Hills & 6% Alisos Canyon

Vintage Conditions: 2019 was an outstanding vintage. It was a very cold winter and a very mild spring and summer leading to slow maturation and long hang times for increased complexities. Harvest was much later in the summer which allows us to harvest under kinder cooler conditions.

Maturation: This wine was matured for 10 months in mostly neutral 500-liter French oak puncheons and foudre.

Color: Light crimson and rhubarb stalk red. Viscous.

Aroma: Enticing collection of dried cherries, peppermint candy, red clay, dried savory herbs and red/black licorice.

Palate: Full bodied with balanced acidity, sweet red fruits of strawberries, cherry pie all wrapped in an earthy package, complemented by refined tannins. Very Grenachey. Fresh, delicious and highly drinkable. Serve slightly chilled.
